

### *David S. Brown Distinguished Sigma Phi Service Award*

Named for long time Sig stalwart David S. Brown S'70, this award was instituted in 1999 to recognize Sig Brothers who have demonstrated their enduring love for our Society through their boundless energy and long-time contributions to its brotherhood and well being. Candidates are among those who form the Society's backbone, to whom the Little Fairy can express thanks for Sigma Phi's continued success.

Any individual or group may make nominations, with or without the knowledge of the nominee. There is no prescribed format for submitting a nomination other than providing us with a comprehensive description of the candidate's contributions (ideally in publishable form).

Elements that have been included in nomination packets over the years:

- Details about how they've been a consistent and enduring supporter to the Society locally and/or nationally over a long period of time
- What positions they've held in the Society as an alumnus, locally and/or nationally
- Undergraduate involvement (positions held, etc.)
- Notable contributions of time, energy, leadership, spirit, etc. ("stories" to highlight their contributions)
- What they've done in their career and community outside of Sigma Phi

Nominations should be directed to me and will remain confidential, revealed only to those brothers who are directly involved in the selection process.
